Examination Reforms:

University Examination Process and Procedures

- Exam schedules are announced 90 days in advance on the RGUHS website.
- Colleges ensure candidates meet eligibility criteria (IA marks & attendance) and activate applications after fee payment.
- Admission tickets are downloaded and distributed by colleges.
- Chief Superintendents download question papers 30 minutes before the exam under surveillance.
- Answer scripts are sealed, documented, and submitted promptly to RGUHS as per guidelines.
- Practical Examinations are conducted after theory examination ensuring smooth and fair proceedings while prioritizing patient comfort.
- Post-Examination answer scripts are verified, coded, and packed securely for evaluation.
- Institution scrupulously abides by the rules established by the University for the Administration of examinations and evaluations.

Process Integrating IT

- Final Internal Assessment marks are uploaded to the university web portal.
- Theory viva and practical examination marks are uploaded to the university web portal on the same day of university practical examination.
- CCTV cameras are installed in examination halls.
- Scanning and uploading of answer scripts on the same day of the examination.
- RGUS will upload all of the scanned answer scripts for digital evaluation.
- Staff will be provided a username and password to evaluate answer scripts. Every paper will be examined by two valuator, and the difference if it exceeds 20 marks will be evaluated by a third valuator. After complete valuation of answer scripts, the results for RGUHS are announced.
- If any grievances, students can apply online for a photocopy of the answer scripts.

Continuous Internal Examination Reform

- Undergraduates undergo three internal examinations within the stipulated time.
- Post-examination, faculty evaluates answer scripts and distributes them to students for doubt clarification or re-correction.
- Marks are displayed on the notice board.
- Final assessment marks, consolidated after the three internals, are uploaded to the university web portal.
- The college conducts a mock preparatory exam for first-year postgraduates ahead of their basic exam.

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Competency-Based Assessment:

- We evaluate the student's competency through overall internal assessment, viva voce, and chair-side discussion components.
- Clinical abilities are examined by assessing the student's work with phantom heads and patient.

Workplace-Based Assessment:

- Students are assessed onsite by faculty during OPD postings, clinical rotations, and pre-clinical laboratories.

Self-Assessment:

- Following the completion of the syllabus, students are given tests that they must grade themselves. Through this practice, they become aware of their weaknesses and are motivated to improve.
