#### **Code of conduct for students:**

- Adherence to Dress Code: Students must follow the prescribed dress code, including wearing appropriate uniforms, personal protective equipment (PPE), and maintaining personal hygiene.
- Use of Technology: Students must use electronic devices, including mobile phones, responsibly and in accordance with institutional guidelines, ensuring that these do not interfere with academic or clinical activities.
- ➤ Communication: Students should communicate respectfully both in person and in written form, ensuring that they maintain professionalism when interacting with faculty, staff, patients, and peers.

### **Code of Conduct for Library:**

- Confidentiality: Staff should respect the privacy of users, ensuring that personal information, including borrowing history, remains confidential.

#### **Code of Conduct for Patients:**

- > Cooperation with Treatment Plans: Patients should follow the prescribed treatment plans and guidelines, as well as communicate any discomfort or concerns during the process.
- > **Timely Appointments:** Patients are encouraged to attend scheduled appointments on time and inform the clinic in advance if rescheduling is necessary.

> Payment and Financial Responsibility: Patients should fulfill financial obligations, adhering to the agreed-upon payment terms and fees associated with treatments.

### **Code of Conduct for Hostel:**

- > Adherence to Curfew: Students must adhere to the hostel curfew times and inform the hostel warden or management if they need to be outside the hostel beyond the prescribed hours.
- > Cleanliness and Hygiene: All students must maintain cleanliness in their rooms, common areas, and bathrooms. This includes proper waste disposal and keeping personal belongings organized.
- ➤ **Respect for Hostel Property:** Hostel property, including furniture, fixtures, and appliances, should be used with care. Damaging or misusing any property will result in disciplinary action.
